The World's COOLEST Airports



Princes Juliana International Airport, Saint Martin - the airplane landing strip is just barely separated by a small metal fence from a populated beach
Madeira, Portugal - this location formerly housed one of the world's shortest runways. In 2000, an extension was completed that spans over a bridge to the water
Paro Airport, Bhutan - this airport is situated deep into a valley, making the landing quite difficult to land
Kansai International Airport, Osaka - in the late 80's Japan created first this new island before building above it a new airport. It also holds the longest passenger terminal in the world
Tenzing-Hillary Airport, Nepal - in 2010, this airport's landing strip was rated THE most dangerous in the world. People fly into here to begin excursions to Mount Everest.
Changi Airport, Singapore - this airport hosts a butterfly garden, an interactive "Enchanted Garden," a sunflower garden, and a "Social Tree," and a free movie theater
Ibrahim Nasir International Airport, Maldives - the scenic view when departing and landing will alone will explain why this airport is so beautifully unique
Helsinki Airport, Finland - this plush airport offers guests a sauna, sleeping pods, a rooftop terrace, and a bar with interior designs that mimics the enchanting Northern Lights
Hong Kong International Airport - here you'll find various art exhibits, a virtual golf course, an IMAX theater, an Aviation Discovery Center, & a SkyDeck roof terrace with views of Chek Lap Kok
Munich Airport, Germany - This airport has its own brewery and served the beer in Europe's largest beer garden. They even host a Christmas market in Nov/Dec!
