Alabama - Space Camp, U.S. @ Space & Rocket Center, and the Russell Cave National Monument
Alaska - See polar bears in natural habitat @ Artic National Wildlife Refuge, and visit the Denali peak
Arizona - Fall asleep in the middle of the Grand Canyon
Arkansas - See Anthony Chapel and the rest of the Garvan Woodland Gardens
California - Drive State Route 1 via Big Sur, and Yosemite National Park.
Colorado - Visit Dinosaur National Monument, raft down the Green or Yampa rivers, and sandboard at Great Sand Dunes National Park
Connecticut - Tour a chain of 365 islands in/around the Stony Creek harbor, and chow down on a white clam pizza at Frank Pepe Pizzeria
