- Balthazar (one of my favorite NYC restaurants) in SoHo for lunch, brunch, or dinner
- Winter Village at Bryant Park (great popup shops, ice skating, and a restaurant)
- Holiday lights on 5th Avenue (breathtaking and will make you feel like a kid!)
- See the Christmas tree, where The Today Show is filmed, and ice skating at Rockefeller Center
- The Macy's Thanksgiving Parade (a must if you are in NYC for Thanksgiving!)
- Westway Diner (you have to dine at a typical NYC diner)
- The Empire State Building (so much fun, amazing views, and a must in NYC!)
- The Nomad Bar (at The Nomad Hotel, currently one of the best bars in America)
- The Smith (Nomad) (great NYC restaurant, had Thanksgiving dinner here)
- 9/11 Memorial (beautiful and heartbreaking)
- Blue Bottle Coffee (a NYC favorite!)
- Chinatown (shop in Chinatown and eat at the Golden Unicorn)
- Little Italy (shop and head to Caffè Roma for hot chocolate and great desserts)
