
Firework Safety Tips for July 4th

| 1. Make sure all lifeworks are supervised by an adult. |

| 2. Do not allow children to light fireworks. |
| 3. Do not point or throw fireworks at others. |
| 4. Keep appropriate fire prevention tools on hand: a hose, bucket of water, or fire extinguisher. |
| 5. Avoid lighting fireworks in a residential area. |
| 6. Position your body away from fireworks when lighting. |
| 7. Avoid setting off large groups of fireworks simultaneously. |
| 8. Never attempt to relight a firework that did not properly ignite. |
| 10. Only use proper vessels for setting off fireworks. |
| 11. Set an appropriate fire safety plan and make sure everyone is aware of the terms. |
