- ☐ Disconnect transmitter battery
- ☐ Disconnect drone battery
- ☐ Power off camera
- ☐ Power off any additional lights or powered equipment
- ☐ Inspect drone for damage, including landing gear, wiring, batteries, propellers, and all connections
- ☐ Wipe drone down
- ☐ Use can of compressed air to blow dust out of components and motor
- ☐ Discharge batteries to prep for transport and storage
- ☐ Dump video footage to computer
- ☐ Clear media cards and storage
- ☐ Place all gear in storage containers

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
