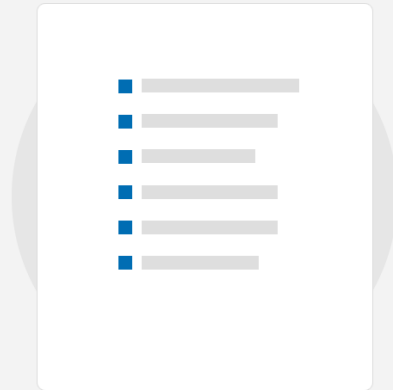


50 Items You Forgot To Put In Your Bug Out Bag
