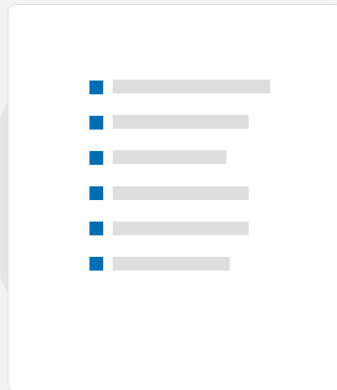


# How Does Every NFL Owner Rank as a Businessperson?
