Postural tachycardia syndrome (PoTS) is an abnormal increase in heart rate that occurs after sitting up or standing. It typically causes dizziness, fainting and other symptoms.



Typical symptoms of PoTS include:

- ☐ Dizziness or light-headedness

- ☐ Shaking and sweating
- ☐ Weakness and fatigue
- ☐ Headaches
- ☐ Poor sleep
