

COMMON SYMPTOMS OF MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS



SENSORY SYMPTOMS

- ☐ Abnormal sensations, such as numbness, tingling, pain, burning, and itching
- ☐ Visual disturbances, including double vision, partial blindness and pain in one eye, dim or blurred vision, and loss of central vision
- ☐ Difficulty in reaching orgasm, lack of sensation in the vagina, and sexual impotence in men
- ☐ Dizziness or vertigo

MOTOR SYMPTOMS

- ☐ Weakness and clumsiness
- ☐ Difficulty walking domain training balance
- ☐ Tremor
- ☐ Uncoordinated eye movements
- ☐ Problems with control of urination and bowel movements
- ☐ Constipation
- ☐ Stiffness, unsteadiness, and unusual fatigue

PSYCHOLOGIC OR NEUROLOGIC SYMPTOMS

- ☐ Inappropriate elation or giddiness

- ☐ Depression
- ☐ Inability to control emotions (for example crying or laughing without reason)
- ☐ Subtle or obvious mental impairment

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
