

COMMON SYMPTOMS OF MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS



SENSORY SYMPTOMS

- Abnormal sensations, such as numbness, tingling, pain, burning, and itching
- Visual disturbances, including double vision, partial blindness and pain in one eye, dim or blurred vision, and loss of central vision
- Difficulty in reaching orgasm, lack of sensation in the vagina, and sexual impotence in men
- Dizziness or vertigo

MOTOR SYMPTOMS

- Weakness and clumsiness
- Difficulty walking, dizziness, and balance
- Tremor
- Uncoordinated eye movements
- Problems with control of urination and bowel movements
- Constipation
- Stiffness, unsteadiness, and unusual fatigue

PSYCHOLOGIC OR NEUROLOGIC SYMPTOMS

- Inappropriate elation or giddiness

Depression

Inability to control emotions (for example crying or laughing without reason)

Subtle or obvious mental impairment
