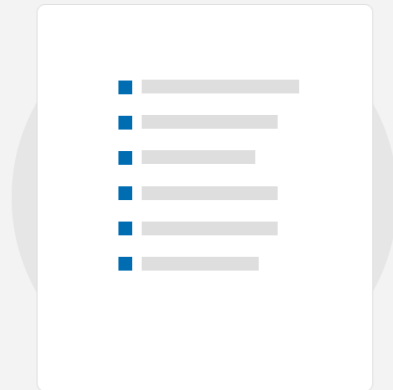


# Fishing equipment checklist for beginners

Free checklist of everything you need to start or go fishing.



- ☐ Fishing License, including applicable stamps and if going on private property written permission
- ☐ Fishing Pole(s), make sure you know the legal limit on how many poles you can use
- ☐ Tackle box (bobbers, extra fishing line, fish stringer, hooks, jigs, leaders, lures, power bait, sinkers and weights)
- ☐ Live Bait (if using minnows consider an air aerator, keep all live bait out of direct sunlight)
- ☐ Map of body of water and/or area you're fishing in
- ☐ Sun Protection; scentless sunscreen and sunglasses
- ☐ First aid kit, should be a small, portable kit designed for camping or outdoors
- ☐ Insect Repellant
- ☐ Portable GPS or fish finder
- ☐ Compass
- ☐ 4"+ fixed bladed knife
- ☐ Needle nose pliers
- ☐ Small bottle of hand sanitizer
- ☐ Camera (avoid using a cell phone to prevent accidental drops into the water)
- ☐ 2 to 3 clean towels
- ☐ Water bottles
- ☐ Rope tape measurer (to measure the length of your future monster catch)
