	must pay attention to what is going on in the background of your selfie. Do not take a selfie when your friends or family are standing behind you. This sometimes leads to photobombing, which, while funny, is likely not an ideal contribution to your
	selfie. Also remove any embarrassing items from the background, such as offensive posters or personal items that you prefer to keep private.
	DON'T: Forget to smile - With all the details involved in taking a good selfie, you risk forgetting about your facial expression
	when taking the photo. Make sure you smile as if you are posing for a professional photographer if you are going for that look. If you opt for a more serious facial expression, preview the picture first before sending it out via social media to make
	sure you express the emotion you want to convey.
