- ☐ What are the most important things you'd like me to accomplish in the first three months if I am hired for this position?
- ☐ Is there anything at all that you'd like me to clarify for you?
- ☐ How do you see my skills and experience fitting with the needs of your company?
- ☐ What are the prospects for growth in this job?
- ☐ What do you enjoy most about working here?
- ☐ How is performance typically measured and reviewed?
- ☐ When do you expect to be making a hiring decision?
- ☐ May I follow up with you to find out your decision? (ask if you may have their business card. This way you'll have their information to follow up and to write a thank you note after the interview.)
