Planning And Requirement Analysis

- ☐ Define the project and product scope;
- ☐ Identity business cases, Concepts, Objects, and rules, economic, Operational, and technical areas;
- ☐ Define preliminary architecture, technical approaches and solutions;
- ☐ Calculate feasibility Of the project Objectives;
- ☐ Organize workshops for stakeholders and users;

Defining Requirements And Designing The Product

- ☐ Create user stories or use cases;
- ☐ Analyses key business objects and high level business requirements;
- ☐ Decompose from a high level requirement to lower level user stories;
- ☐ Fill up and prioritize the backlog;
- ☐ Takes part in deeper risk analysis, in architecture design and in the creation Of acceptance criteria for testing.

Developing The Product

- ☐ Works with finishing and polishing the requirements;
- ☐ Support the development process by clarifying requirements;

- ☐ Gathering remaining user and Service Desk requirements.

Testing The Product

- ☐ Assists QA(quality assurance) team with review test plans and scripts, sign-off of functional and non-functional test results;
- ☐ Takes part in planning and conducting the user Acceptance Testing (UAT) and assess the results;
- ☐ Plans further user trainings.

Deployment In The Market And Maintenance

- ☐ Coordinates the processes of the production deployment and integration in customer's business environment;
- ☐ Supports management;
- ☐ Take part in pre-implementation readiness review and post- implementation review.

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
