

Pokemon Diamond and Pearl Post-Game Completionist Checklist

List of Post-Game Objectives to Complete in Pokemon Diamond and Pearl for the Nintendo DS. There is not a "bonus" for completing all of these objectives beyond the Diploma for completing the National Pokedex. This list is designed to help the player experience the most possible out of the games.



Pokedex Entries

- See all 150 Pokemon in the Sinnoh Pokedex (not including Manaphy)
 - Speak to Professor Rowan and Professor Oak in the lab in Sandgem Town to obtain the National Pokedex
 - Obtain the PokeRadar from Professor Rowan in the lab in Sandgem Town after receiving the National Pokedex
- Register all 150 Pokemon as caught in the Sinnoh Pokedex (not including Manaphy) -- See this checklist: bit.ly/DiamondPearlPokedex
 - Complete a "Living Pokedex" of all 150 Pokemon stored in the PC -- for example, store a Turtwig, Grotle, and a Torterra in the PC in Pokedex Number order.
- Collect all Trophy Garden Daily Pokemon

- Capture the Special and Legendary Pokemon not included in the Sinnoh Pokedex:
 - Rotom - Static Encounter at the Old Chateau inside the TV at night
 - Heatran - Static Encounter in the Stark Mountain innermost room **Note: complete the sidequest with Buck to defeat Team Galactic in Stark Mountain then talk to Buck in the Survival Area. Return to Stark Mountain alone to encounter Heatran.
 - Regigigas - Static Encounter in Snowpoint Temple B5F **Note: Must transfer Regirock, Regice, and Registeel from Ruby/Sapphire/Emerald and have them in the party to interact with Regigigas
 - Giratina - Static Encounter in Turnback Cave, in the chamber past the room with 3rd pillar (Surf off Route 214 to the Spring Path after obtaining the National Pokedex, then follow the path to Sendoff Spring and use Rock Climb)
 - Cresselia - Roaming Sinnoh after encountering on Full Moon Island. After obtaining the National Pokedex, go to the Sailor's House in Canalave City and talk about the sick son. Then, travel to Full Moon Island and interact with Cresselia. Grab the Lunar Wing and return to the Sailor's son, then encounter throughout Sinnoh.
- Complete the National Pokedex (482 Pokemon -- does not include Mew, Ho-Oh, Lugia, Celebi, Jirachi, Deoxys, Phione, Manaphy, Darkrai, Shaymin, and Arceus)
 - Receive the Diploma from a designer in a house south of Lake Valor
 - Complete a "Living Pokedex" of all 482 Pokemon stored in the PC
- Bonus: Capture the additional Generation IV Mythical Pokemon
 - Note: Event Pokemon may be obtained through use of an Action Replay or through a Wi-Fi exploit affecting Generation IV and V that can be read about here: bit.ly/PokemonWiFiExploit. Additionally, guides for a possible "walk-through-walls" glitch are available. Only attempt obtaining these event Pokemon if understanding the risks of corrupting the save file.
 - Darkrai - Event Pokemon not currently obtainable through standard gameplay.
 - Shaymin - Event Pokemon not currently obtainable through standard gameplay.
 - Arceus - Event Pokemon not currently obtainable through standard gameplay.
 - Manaphy - Not currently obtainable via standard gameplay. It is possible, yet unlikely, to transfer a Manaphy Egg from Pokemon Ranger after finishing the post-game content. However, these games had one Manaphy Egg per cartridge and it is unlikely to find a cartridge that has not redeemed the egg.

- Phone - Not currently obtainable through standard gameplay. Breed Manaphy with Ditto and hatch the resulting egg.

In-Game Trades

- Oreburgh City - Trade a Machop to Hilary for an Abra, located in a large two-story house in the northwest. Nicknamed "Kazza."
- Eterna City - Trade a Buizel to Norton for a Chatot, located in the Eterna Condominiums. Nicknamed "Charap" and has all five Contest conditions raised by 20 with a sheen of 0.
- Snowpoint City - Trade a Medicham to Mindy for Haunter, located in the northwesternmost house. Holds an Everstone, preventing evolution to Gengar. Nicknamed "Gaspar."
- Route 226 - Trade a Finneon to Meister for a German Magikarp, located in the house on the small island. Also unlocks the Foreign Pokedex entries option. Nicknamed "Foppa" and unlocks the German Pokedex entry for Magikarp

- #17 Calendar - Obtained from a Poketch developer by Pokemon Rock in Sunyshore City after showing him a Pokemon with a serious nature (requires Rock Climb)

Battle Tower (and other battles)

- Complete a 21-match win-streak in single battles, defeating Tower Tycoon Palmer the first time.
- Complete a 49-match win-streak in single battles, defeating Tower Tycoon Palmer the second time.
- Achieve a 100-match win-streak in single battles
- Defeat the Rival on two separate occasions on the weekends in the Fight Area after defeating the Elite Four for the first time
 - Defeat Phase 1 - Rival's Starter Pokemon is level 64
 - Defeat Phase 2 - Rival's Starter Pokemon is level 74 (occurs after defeating the Elite Four 20 times)

Underground Rewards received from the Underground Man in Eterna City

- Move Trap (Up), Bubble Trap, Leaf Trap - Use the Explorer Kit and go to The Underground
- Prism Sphere 1, Red Sphere 1, Blue Sphere 1 - Dig something out of a wall
- Digger Drill - Plant a sphere in the ground
- Plain Table, Wooden Chair, Small Bookshelf, Buneary Doll - Dig a Secret Base
- Doll of the player's starter (Turtwig, Chimchar, or Piplup) - Decorate a Secret Base
- Bronze Flag, ability to remove 3 boulders, Base Upgrade (12 decorations), Pretty Gem - Capture a flag from another player's secret base
- Silver Flag, ability to remove 5 boulders, Base Upgrade (15 decorations), Shiny Gem - Capture three flags from another player's secret base
- Gold Flag, ability to remove 10 boulders, Mystic Gem, radar to show locations of treasure/spheres/traps - Capture 10 flags from another player's secret base
- Platinum Flag, ability to remove all boulders, Glitter Gem, a star on the trainer card - Capture 50 flags from another player's secret base

Trainer Card -- Obtain a black Trainer Card by earning 5 stars

- Defeat the Elite Four and enter the Hall of Fame
- Defeat the Master Rank in at least one Super Contest category

- Obtain the Platinum Flag in the Underground by capturing 50 flags -- requires at least one additional player
- Complete the National Pokedex (482 Pokemon, see above)
- Achieve a 100-match win-streak in single battles in the Battle Tower

- Access the Ribbon Syndicate - have at least 10 *different kinds* of ribbons spread among Pokemon in the Party
 - Purchase a Gorgeous Ribbon - ¥10,000
 - Purchase a Royal Ribbon - ¥100,000
 - Purchase a Royal-Gorgeous Ribbon - ¥999,999
- Locate all Plates -- May be found in the Underground also
 - Draco Plate - Eterna City, behind the statue (Dowsing Machine)
 - Dread Plate - Old Chateau, first room on the left in the upstairs area
 - Earth Plate - Oreburgh Gate, head to the basement (Rock Smash) and west on the water. Located near a boulder that must be moved with strength
 - Fist Plate - Route 215, near a Karate Trainer past a tree that must be cut, middle of the route
 - Flame Plate - Stark Mountain, in the room where first meet Buck, head east, down stairs to the north, then up stairs to the west, then immediately down stairs to the west, hidden on the wall to the far west (Dowsing Machine)
 - Icicle Plate - Route 217, talk to a man inside the house on the west-side of the route (next to where HM08 was received)
 - Insect Plate - Old Chateau Outside, on the cliff wall immediately to the east of the house (Dowsing Machine)
 - Iron Plate - Iron Island, take the east stairs, down the elevator, take the west stairs, immediately south past a male and female karate trainer, in a small depression to the far south (Dowsing Machine)
 - Meadow Plate - Route 210, east from Celestic Town, cross the first bridge, go upstairs, cross the second bridge, go right across the third, downstairs twice to get to the water, then climb the waterfall and search the northwest corner wall (Dowsing Machine)
 - Mind Plate - Solaceon Ruins, top right, bottom left, top right, top left, top left, then bottom left
 - Sky Plate - Victory Road Exit, near the flower patch to the west, three spaces down from the western statue (Dowsing Machine)
 - Splash Plate - Route 220, southwestern area of route, on the beach south of two swimming bikini girls

- Spooky Plate - Amity Square, next to the second rock hut that is near the east-side entrance, to the right of the boy with Drifloon
- Stone Plate - Mt. Coronet Peak, locate the outdoor snowy area where able to use Rock Climb, climb the first wall and enter the cave to the east. Surf on the water to the west then use waterfall and enter the room. Search the rock in the center of the room (Dowsing Machine)
- Toxic Plate - Great Marsh Area 2, far northeast corner, hiding in the fourth tree from the corner (Dowsing Machine)
- Zap Plate - In front of the Sunyshore City Lighthouse (Dowsing Machine)
- Obtain all Seals
 - Purchase all Monday Seals at the Sunyshore City Market (Heart Seal A, Star Seal B, Line Seal C, Ele-Seal B, Fire Seal A, Party Seal D, Song Seal A)
 - Purchase all Tuesday Seals at the Sunyshore City Market (Heart Seal B, Star Seal C, Line Seal D, Ele-Seal C, Fire Seal B, Flora Seal A, Song Seal B)
 - Purchase all Wednesday Seals at the Sunyshore City Market (Heart Seal C, Star Seal D, Smoke Seal A, Ele-Seal D, Fire Seal C, Flora Seal B, Song Seal C)
 - Purchase all Thursday Seals at the Sunyshore City Market (Heart Seal D, Star Seal E, Smoke Seal B, Foamy Seal A, Fire Seal D, Flora Seal C, Song Seal D)
