Windows Ping Command Options How to Use Ping Command on Linux?



- ☐ -t : Continuous ping. ping 172.22.82.1 -t
- ☐ -n: Number of ping packet. D ping 172.22.82.1 -n 2
- ☐ -l : Size of the ping packet. -> ping 172.22.82.1 -l 200
- ☐ -i : The value of TTL. ping 172.22.82.1 -i 200
- ☐ -w: TO adjust the time-out. ping 172.22.82.1 -w 2000
- ☐ -f : Sets the Do Not Fragment bit -> ping 172.22.82.1 -f
- ☐ -a: To resolve, the hostname of a target. -> ping 172.22.82.1 -a
