

# Online Learning Tips for Parents

If your preschool or Pre-K child is attending a LIVE online class, here are some things you can do to help it go more smoothly.



- ☐ 1. Set up your computer so your child can easily see the computer screen and can remain hands free to draw or participate in an action oriented activity.
- ☐ 2. Try to have your child facing a window or other source of light so that the teacher can better see and talk to your child.
- ☐ 3. Choose a room where your child will be able to hear and turn off any background noise or other competing sounds.
- ☐ 4. Plan to stay with your child so that you can encourage your child to participate in the lesson.
- ☐ 5. Listen in to what the teacher is reading or sharing so that you can talk about it with your child after the lesson is over.
- ☐ 6. Use any content your child's teacher provides as a springboard for extending the learning at home.
- ☐ 7. Keep the rest of your day focused on real life learning through play and exploration.
