- ☐ #198 Kyogre - Static Encounter in the Marine Cave after defeating the Elite Four. This location changes. If a scientist in the Weather Institute says there is "Heavy Rain," head to that route, dive in a small dark spot, and follow the path to Kyogre.
- ☐ #199 Groudon - Static Encounter in the Terra Cave after defeating the Elite Four. This location changes. If a scientist in the Weather Institute says there is "Drought," head to that route, enter the new cave, and follow the path to Groudon.
- ☐ #200 Rayquaza - Static Encounter on the Sky Pillar. Must initially encounter it during the main quest and have it fly away to confront Groudon and Kyogre. After seeing the cut-scene involving Groudon, Kyogre, and Rayquaza in Sootopolis City, it is

possible to return to the Sky Pillar and catch Rayquaza immediately.

- ☐ #201 Jirachi - Event Pokemon not obtainable through standard gameplay. May be obtained using a cheating device or from the Pokemon Colosseum Pre-Order Bonus Disc for GameCube (US Only) or Pokemon Channel for GameCube (PAL Region Only)
- ☐ #202 Deoxys - Event Pokemon not obtainable through standard gameplay. May be obtained using a cheating device to complete the Birth Island event or may be added to a cheating device directly.

After receiving the National Pokedex and reaching the Battle Frontier, the following important or exclusive tasks become available:

- ☐ Capture Ditto - Enter the Fossil Maniac house in Fallarbor town and encounter it in the Desert Underpass. Provides convenience for breeding Pokemon.
- ☐ Capture Sudowoodo - East in the Battle Frontier, water the strange tree with the Wailmer Pail (only available in Emerald)
- ☐ Capture Smeargle - Go down the waterfall past the Sudowoodo then surf to the west and enter the Artisan's Cave (only available in Emerald)

After completing the Hoenn Pokedex (not including Jirachi or Deoxys), the following activity may be completed:

- ☒ Receive one of the Johto Starters from Professor Birch in Littleroot Town: Chikorita, Cyndaquil, or Totodile
