- ☐ #251 Celebi - Not currently obtainable on a Gameboy Color Cartridge through standard gameplay. Required connection to the Pokemon Mobile Phone System in Japan. May be available through exploits which may corrupt the save file, see this website: bit.ly/CelebiEggGlitch
- ☐ On the 3DS Virtual Console - After defeating the Elite Four, receive the GS Ball at the Goldenrod City Pokemon Center and give it to Kurt in Azalea Town. After 24 hours, return to Kurt then take the GS Ball to the shrine in Ilex Forest for a Static Encounter with Celebi. This Celebi can be transferred to Pokemon Bank and home regularly.

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
