
COMMON SYMPTOMS OF MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS



SENSORY SYMPTOMS

Abnormal sensations, such as numbness, tingling, pain, burning, and itching					
Visual disturbances, including double vision, partial blindness and pain in one eye, dim or blurred vision, and loss of central vision					
Difficulty in reaching orgasm, lack of sensation in the vagina, and sexual impotence in men					
Dizziness or vertigo

Weakness and clumsiness					
Difficulty walking domain training balance					
Tremor					
Uncoordinated eye movements					
Problems with control of urination and bowel movements					
Constipation					
Stiffness unsteadiness and unusual fatigue
