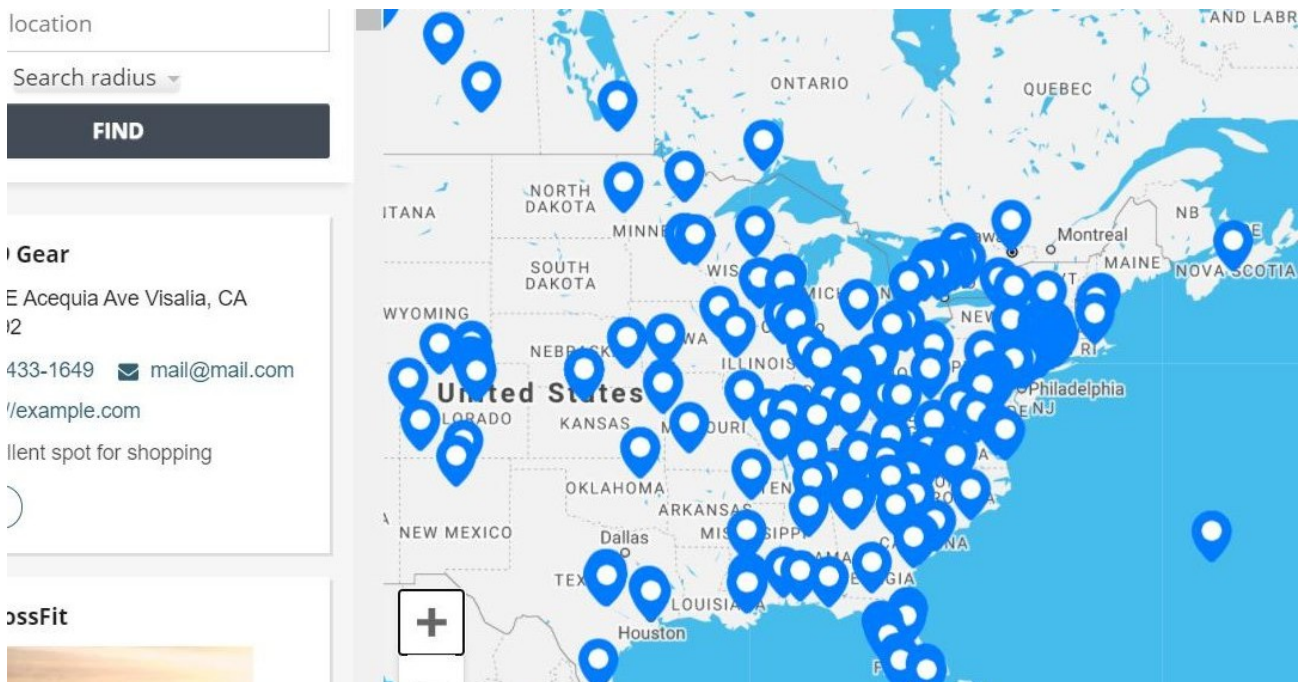


5 Google Maps API Alternatives

- ☐ Fully customizable

- ☐ It has a few map data limitations

Openstreet Map

- ☐ 100% free
- ☐ Constantly updated database
- ☐ It can't be used without a mapping service solution
- ☐ Limited data exchange volume

Tomtom

- ☐ High reputation when it comes to mapping and navigation

- ☐ Offers vectors maps, traffic density, location search, and route finding
- ☐ Price reduces with large volume requests
- ☐ API not constantly improved

OmsAnd

- ☐ Same core functionality as Google Maps
- ☐ Fully customizable
- ☐ Excellent offline usability
- ☐ Relies on Openstreet map to get map data

Leaflet

- ☐ Open-source API
- ☐ JavaScript data library
- ☐ Fully customizable
- ☐ Compatible with other mapping services
- ☐ Needs third-party services to support configuration
- ☐ Requires a developer (or developer skills) to use it

Storemapper

- ☐ An excellent API alternative
- ☐ Mobile-friendly
- ☐ Allows you to upload new locations information to your map easily
- ☐ Robust analytics dashboard that helps you track your map and location's performance
- ☐ Highly customizable and with free presets and settings included in every plan
