

How to Style a Cocktail Glass

Use this checklist to help you create a beautifully styled cocktail glass for your next cocktail party.



- ☐ Pick a theme for your cocktail party, tropical, elegant garden party, etc
- ☐ Use Pinterest to find at least two cocktail recipes that you like that also relate to your cocktail theme
- ☐ Decide what cocktail glasses you need, shop for really nice plastic ones so you have enough for your guests and for easy clean up <https://goo.gl/x7EiJU>
- ☐ Shop for colorful, sparkly, or glitter sugar for the rim of your cocktails <https://goo.gl/LP1M4u>
- ☐ Use pretty paper straws that you can easily cut down to fit your cocktail glasses <https://goo.gl/9ePljn>
- ☐ Edible flowers look beautiful to decorate around or in your cocktails <https://goo.gl/N3to5j>
- ☐ You can also freeze flowers or fruit in ice trays to make pretty ice cubes for your drinks or to decorate the ice in your ice bucket
- ☐ Certain cocktails also look a lot better with crushed ice
- ☐ If making sangria use lots of different fruit for color and different favors
- ☐ Use cookie cutters to make fruit shapes
- ☐ Cocktail sticks are great for creating mini fruit kabobs for your drinks
- ☐ Garnish your cocktail with cotton candy for a fun cocktail look
- ☐ Add food coloring to create fun colors or to make a drink more vibrant.
- ☐ Or you could even set up a bar and let your guest create their own unique cocktails.
